Presentation by Julian Barnwell, one of two brothers who found the wreck, and Lord Dannatt, chair of the Gloucester 1682 Trust.

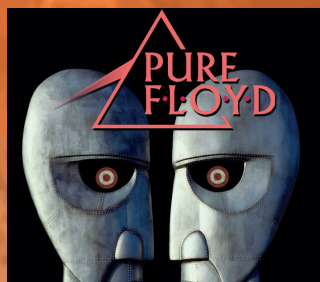


PURE FLOYD PERFORMANCE
